POP-UP ART Minnesota artist Thomas Allen uses vintage books and pulp fiction to create photographs of cliff-hanging adventures and femmes fatales. He cuts out figures from the covers or pages of books, poses the cut-outs to create miniature dramas, and photographs them. The new exhibit "Uncovered" includes images of a ship bobbing on a paper sea, a seductress rising from a stack of novels, and castaways bobbing above a waterlogged volume.
